August 18, 2015 (Columbus, GA) – One in four women will be a victim of domestic violence during her lifetime. Much closer to home, last year Columbus police responded to over 3,400 domestic violence calls.

Local domestic violence shelter Hope Harbour is excited to announce **Celebration of Hope**, a fundraising event that will take place at the Columbus GA Convention & Trade Center on Thursday, September 17, 2015. “This annual luncheon helps tell Hope Harbour’s story. Our speaker will be *New York Times* bestselling author, Leslie Morgan Steiner. Steiner’s memoir, *Crazy Love*, is about surviving domestic violence in her first marriage. At 22, Steiner seemed to have it all: good looks, a Harvard diploma, and a glamorous job in New York City plus a handsome, funny boyfriend who adored her. But behind her façade of success, this golden girl hid a dark secret. She’d made a mistake shared by millions: she fell in love with the wrong person,” says Board President Bonnie Kennedy. “It is going to be a wonderful lunch to raise money for our local domestic violence shelter and support those in need.”
