Columbus, GA (September 7, 2016) – Georgia is ranked 12th in the nation for females killed by males. Much closer to home, in 2014 there were 22 homicides in Muscogee County – 10 were related to family violence. Often victims leave their homes with nothing and turn to domestic violence shelters for safety and support.

Local domestic violence shelter Hope Harbour is excited to announce **Celebration of Hope**, a fundraising event that will take place at the Columbus GA Convention & Trade Center on Thursday October 6, 2016. 
